**13.1: ENTENTE REPORT:** Based on the recommendations of IQAC, ENTENTE 2021 was organised a virtual conference. #### **13.2: IPR Seminar**

IQAC team instructed the Academic office to take necessary steps in this direction.

#### **13.3: Doctoral Program in Supporting Areas**

IQAC members strongly encouraged supporting areas of Humanities and Social Sciences to start working on initiating a doctoral program in the given field. This will enable the faculty members to engage in more rigorous research and will attract research-oriented students to NU. In a way, this will enable the environment of research and research-oriented mindset to take seed in the campus and flourish here onwards.

#### **13.4: Effective lecture delivery.**

The use of ICT tools (Google classroom, Canvas, Kahoot, Prezi) in classroom sessions make them interactive and effective. The IQAC members appreciated the efforts of the faculty members in this direction.



**13.5: Training the students to improve professional competency enhancing placement opportunities.**

The members of IQAC opined that the short-term courses can be offered in different subject areas to make the students more competent for better job opportunities. These courses may be referred to as certificate courses.
